1991 CVOA NATIONAL ROUND-UP ATLANTA, GEORGIA

Sixty hearty souls attended this year's national roundup in Atlanta, Georgia. With Fred Kieffer as Roundup Chairman, the weather cleared for the three day event for the first time in many weeks. Rain was a constant companion in the southeast until the Roundup weekend.

It was held in conjunction with the "American Fare" car show sponsored by the Stone Mountain Street Machine Association. The Cosworths were given a special area next to the street machines. Many passer-bys were intrigue with the Cosworths and asked many questions which were answered by our members. Judging was done two ways this year.

The members were allowed to vote on the "best" classes while the our judges looked over the Cosworths for the over-all awards. Some of the highlights were Dan File's Cosworth with power brakes, cruise and reupholstered seats in black and gold with "Cosworth Vega" embroidered on the gold seat area inlays, Bob Chin's much talked about but never seen before Cosworth finally made it's first show appearance, Lou Marr's Imron painted Cosworth once again showed how great black paint can look when it is expertly applied.




